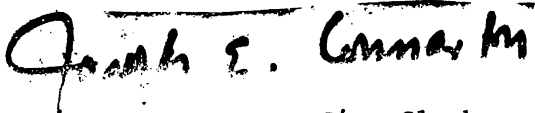
FEBRUARY 13, 1989

- WHEREAS: The 1986 Federal tax law created the "earned income credit", a benefit on federal tax form for low-income working people, that in some case, is worth \$874 in additional income; and
- WHEREAS: It has been reported that only 15% of those eligible, who live below the poverty level, are taking advantage of this tax credit; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to ensure that any City Employees who might be eligible for these "Earned income credit" are so informed; and be it further
- ORDERED: That through the Human Services Department, Cable T.V., and other appropriate agencies, the citizens are given correct information about this credit.
