That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining banners, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to **Cambridge Public Health Department** for a temporary banner across Massachusetts Avenue from City Hall to the YMCA, advertising "*Cambridge celebrates World No Tobacco Day - May 31.*"

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the installation, maintenance and use of said banner.
