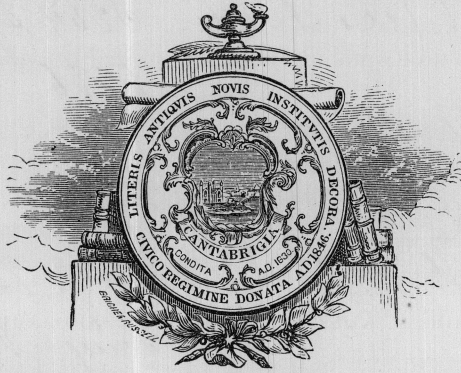


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen, *February 19, 1872,*

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Walnut Street
be extended to River Street,
to connect with Kent Street,

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land ~~as~~ *between*

Pleasant and River Streets

as is included between the *lines* shown on a plan of *extension of Walnut*
Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *July 10, 1872* and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Walnut*
Street.
