## WHEREAS:-

It is the sense of the City Council that the voters of Cambridge should be given an opportunity to voice their opinions in the election to be held on November 4 on the issue of whether or not they favor the enactment of an ordinance designed to control the spiraling rents in this city, now therefore be it

## RESOLVED:-

That the following measure be submitted to a vote of the registered voters of Cambridge for adoption or rejection at the November 4, 1969 municipal election:

Be it RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cambridge that the Council exercise all powers conferred upon it by the City Charter and the Constitution and any general or special laws of the Commonwealth to enact an ordinance which will

1. Establish maximum rents for housing accommodations in the city;
2. Establish a rent board with power to adjust such maximum rents;
3. Provide for appropriate sanctions for enforcement and appropriate rights of appeal;

and, to that end, to petition the General Court to enact such legislation as may be required to establish or confirm the power of the City Council to enact such a rent control ordinance.
