Subject Council Order #6 - 4/30/79 - Conditions at Disposal Area in East Cambridge

Enclosed is a copy of a report from the Fire Prevention Bureau, Deputy Chief Ernest Gelinas, regarding the above order. Earlier this year, the Reclamation Plant was full to the limits with rubbish and various assortments of debris. The Fire Department filed a complaint in 3rd District Court to force compliance with Chapter 148 of the General Laws. This case was postponed several times before a hearing was finally held and then the hearing was continued. In the interim, the plant was thoroughly cleaned up, and this report of Deputy Gelinas (6/4/79) indicates a satisfactory condition at the present time.

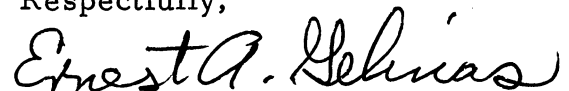
Subject: Reclamation Systems

Sir:

The above premises on East Street in the B & M Yards, East Cambridge, have recently been completely cleaned. It is now under operation of B.F.I. Disposal. Fire Protection includes sprinklers and a standpipe for one line of hose. Watchman service is provided around the clock. Rubbish has been kept to a minimum. Most that is brought in is trucked out each day. A net has been placed around perimeter to prevent wind-blown rubbish.

Possibility of additional hydrants in area is being investigated by owners.

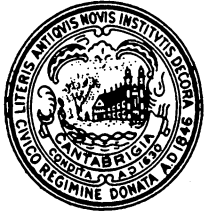

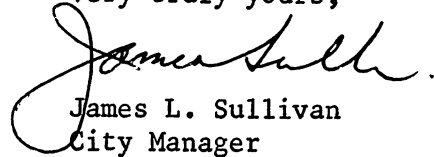
