WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino moved again with his family, to the City of Cambridge, in 1913; and

WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino has been a resident of the City of Cambridge since his immigration in 1913 and has been an important and involved member of our community; and

WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino married Catherine Canina on April 25, 1925 in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino and Catherine Canina were married for 72 years and from this union came four children, Ralph, the late Francis, the late Rita Sabatino Mariano, and Salvatore; and

WHEREAS: The four children of Orlando Sabatino have given him 18 grandchildren and 38 great grandchildren and 2 great-great grandchildren; and

WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino worked for many years for BF Goodrich Company and maintaining apartment buildings; and

WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino entertained several generations of residents of Cambridge and surrounding communities as leader of his orchestra, Orlan King and the Eight Blue Notes; and

WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino has been an active member of the Santa Lucia Society and Sacred Heart Church, and he coached youth baseball and has participated in many other community activities throughout his life in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Orlando Sabatino speaks seven languages, plays four instruments, and taught music in Boston's North End and to neighborhood youth; now therefor be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record dedicating the square at the intersection of May Street, Saint Saveur Court, and Lawn Street in honor of Orlando Sabatino; and be it further

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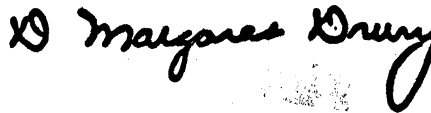
