The Public Aid Committee reports, pursuant to the rules of the City Council, that it has obtained from the Secretary of the Board of Public Welfare and from the W.P.A. Sponsor monthly reports for the Month of August.

The Board of Public Welfare reports on Old Age Assistance cases, three more than at the end of July, and on General Relief and Aid to Dependent Children twenty-four cases less than at the end of July. These classes of cases cost the City \$116,578.04, during the Month of August, an increase of \$5,782.

The Sponsor's Agent reports seven hundred and sixty persons employed during the Month of August on W.P.A. projects, an increase of thirteen from the previous month. The cost for August was \$5,285.32 to the City, a decrease of \$2,114.20 and \$51,226.94 to the Federal Government, an increase of \$2,250.65. One hundred and sixteen persons were placed in private employment by the Municipal Employment Bureau, of whom 51 were from Welfare.
