Dear Mr. Corcoran:

As you remember we did not place any money in the school budget to cover teachers' salary raises or adequate money to cover the raises of other personnel because in January, 1973 and February, 1973, you asked that we not establish a figure until you had concluded some agreements with city personnel.

We have now reached an agreement with the bargaining unit of the Cambridge Teachers Association and with the School Department Custodians for percentage raises in line with those you have negotiated with the Department of Public Works. Accordingly, the School Committee has sent you an Order requesting an additional appropriation of \$368,901.00 (\$420,287.00 less \$51,386.00 that we had in the budget).

In brief the salary agreement with the Cambridge Teachers Association calls for a 3% increase in September, 1973, and an identical raise in September, 1974, and a cost of living raise effective January 1, 1975.

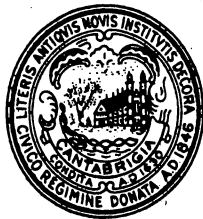
The agreement with the School Custodians is identical with the agreement you signed with the Department of Public Works except that the dates are earlier because the custodians former contract expired on September 1, 1972.

We hope that you will see fit to place this additional item before the City Council.
