

- WHEREAS: Public safety of the residents of the City of Cambridge, and of the visitors to the Harvard Square area, is of the utmost concern to the Cambridge City Council; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge wishes to comply with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Building Code and the Architectural Barriers Regulations concerning curb cuts at the cross walks for the handicapped; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to inspect the slope of the curb cuts on Dawes Island at the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Garden Street; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to report back to the City Council in one week on the status of the curb cuts in relation to compliance with the Architectural Barriers Regulations; and in the event of non-compliance, to report on the steps necessary to bring the curb cuts into compliance.
