WHEREAS: CFLs are beneficial to the environment, saving more energy and lasting longer than incandescent bulbs; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record as thanking NSTAR for supporting the CFL program which benefits the environment and individual schools; and be it further
