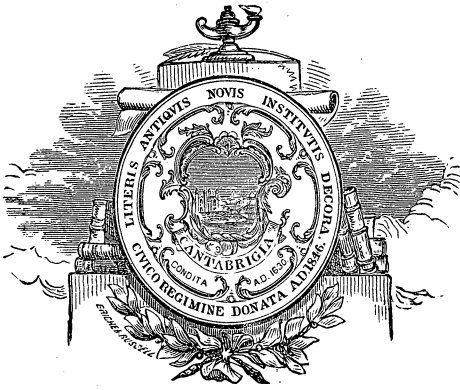




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

May 21. 1883

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Plymouth Street
between Windsor and Hampshire streets, and
Webster Avenue

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet*
in width between *Windsor* and *Hampshire*
Streets and *Webster Avenue*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *Charles D. Elliot*,
dated *Sept. 1875*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,
