Sir:

Progress report with regards to the breaks that occurred at the Cambridge Rindge Latin High School on December 2, 14 and 15.

With the help of Sidney Yedell, the Security Chief at the High School, three names of Juveniles were supplied to the investigating officers, Detectives Aurelio Ferreira and Spencer Franklin. Two of the names were eliminated on the second day. The prime suspect, a male juvenile attending CRLS was then focused on.

The investigating officers learned the suspect stopped going to school and was unable to be contacted.

The week of January 18th Detective Aurelio Ferreira received information as a result of the on-going investigation, which resulted in the issuance of a search warrant for 64A Beacon Street, Somerville.

On January 28, 1982 at 1:00 p.m., the search warrant was executed. Pursuant to the search warrant 32 Kodak Instamatic cameras, property of CRLS, were seized. Approximately \$ 3,000.00 in assorted stereo equipment reported stolen in Cambridge on January 28, 1982 was also recovered at this time in the apartment.

The previous week a Savin Copier, Model 775, valued at \$ 3,400.00 was recovered by the Somerville Police in a garage in the rear of 64A Beacon Street and was returned to CRLS.

As the result of information received, recovered 12 more Kodak Instamatic cameras, property of CRLS.

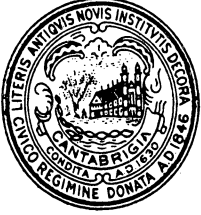
Court action has been taken against one male juvenile, a resident of 64A Beacon Street, Somerville.
