Subject Council Order #1 of Aug. 3, 1987 "Bus Stops at Huron Ave. and Concord Ave."

We have reviewed the current bus stop locations at the intersections of Huron Ave. and Concord Ave. with the MBTA. An agreement to combine the two bus stops for outbound buses was reached.

We will remove the stop on west side of Huron Ave. in front of Armandos Pizza shop and the stop on the north side of Concord Ave. at the gas station. These will be replaced with a stop on Concord Ave. just before Huron Avenue.

The inbound bus stop on Concord Ave. was adjusted last year to provide additional parking. The stop on Huron Ave. at Manassas Ave. allows the trackless trolleys room to maneuver and turn onto Concord Ave. safely. It is also not in front of any homes.
