MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: Cities and towns in Massachusetts are facing continued uncertainty in regards to local aid for special programs including, bond issues for capital projects, special education, and toxic waste; and
- WHEREAS: Cities in towns in Massachusetts are under restrictions to increases beyond 2 1/2 percent in the tax levy without approval of the local governing body and a Home Rule Petition voted by the State Legislature funding continues to be precarious for the foreseeable future; and
- WHEREAS: In the legislature House 5166 **An Act Relative to Regulating the Limits Established for the Taxation of Property in Cities and Towns** would allow cities and towns to raise revenue with the majority approval of a city council or local governing body for the funding of special projects; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That this City Council hereby requests the City Manager to take necessary steps to register the support of this body in favor of House 5166 which would allow majorities of local governing bodies to raise revenue above the mandated 2 1/2 levies.
