An Ordinance

In further addition to "An Ordinance providing
for the care and management of the Cambridge
Water Works."

Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Cambridge, as follows: -

Sec. 1. All hydrants established by the City shall
be constructed, and all repairs upon such hy-
-drants shall be made, and the streets, if broken up,
again put in good order, to the satisfaction of the
Superintendent of Streets and Drains, by and
under the direction of the Water Board.

Sec. 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances
inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
