follows:

Section 1. Chapter 25 of the Revised Ordinances is
hereby amended by adding at the end thereof
the following sections, to be numbered respectively
Sections 36, 37, 38, & 39.

WATERING STREETS.

37/ ~~37~~ Appropriation for watering streets. | ~~38~~ Making of Contracts.
38/ ~~38~~ Sum to be paid.

37/ SECT. ~~37~~ Whenever any appropriation of money shall have been made by the City Council for watering streets, no part of said appropriation shall be expended except by order of the ^{standing} Committee on Roads and Bridges ^{of the Board of Aldermen} and upon a warrant drawn by the Mayor upon the City Treasurer, and duly countersigned by the Auditor.

38/ SECT. ~~38~~ No greater sum shall be paid for watering any street than the amount actually paid to the Committee by persons residing on said street. ^{Sum to be paid.} ^{of the Board of Aldermen}

39/ SECT. ~~39~~ ^{standing} The Committee on Roads and Bridges shall contract with some suitable person or persons, for watering any street or streets, when an amount equal to one half the expense thereof shall first have been subscribed and paid into the hands of the chairman of said committee; but no money shall be paid from said appropriation for any watering not done in pursuance of a contract so made. ^{Making of Contracts.}
