1. Order introduced by Councillor Vellucci directing the City Manager to confer with the appropriate state & local agencies in an effort to determine the level of health hazards which may be created by the establishment of CARD Districts. (Order #8 of 9/17/84)
2. Order introduced by Councillor David Sullivan requesting that the public hearing scheduled by the Council relative to the issuance of Industrial Revenue Bonds for the proposed development at 871 Mass. Avenue also include the boundaries of the entire CARD District, in order that the Council may consider any boundary change. (Order #9 of 9/17/84)
3. Order introduced by Councillor Duehay requesting the establishment of a representative committee of appropriate individuals to review accomplishments to date & future accomplishments of all Cambridge Area Revitalization Districts (CARD), inclusive of criteria for the selection of an area to be designated as a CARD. 4. Order introduced by Councillor Graham requesting the City Manager to meet with the Mass. Industrial Financing Authority (M.I.F.A.), requesting that they delay final approval of the issuance of Industrial Revenue Bonds to the proposed developer of 871 Mass. Avenue. (Order #11 of 9/17/84)


