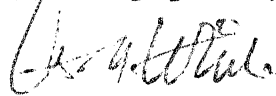
This office represents and is writing on behalf of Crystal Transport, Inc. of Brighton, Massachusetts. We are writing to request the issuance of a license pursuant to Chapter 159A Section 1 to operate motor vehicles over certain public ways in your city as set forth in the enclosed proposed license.

The transportation operation to be conducted by Crystal Transport, Inc. involves the carriage of students and faculties of Wellesley College and Massachusetts Institute of Technology between campuses in Wellesley and Cambridge. This operation has been conducted in the past and is currently being provided at this time by other carriers pursuant to previous authority issued by your city and/or the Department of Public Utilities for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Crystal Transport, Inc. has been awarded the contract to provide the service. It will be able to provide this service, however, only upon the procurement of the necessary city licenses and certification from the Department of Public Utilities.

Subject License to Operate Shuttle Bus (Crystal Transport Inc.)

We have reviewed the proposal from Crystal Transport, Inc. to operate a bus shuttle between MIT and Wellesley to accommodate students in an MIT-Wellesley College exchange program.

We cannot recommend approval of the bus route which was originally requested as it went through Harvard Square.

We do recommend approval be granted for Crystal Transport, Inc. to operate a shuttle bus service on the following public ways in the City of Cambridge.

River Street from Memorial Drive to Massachusetts Avenue
Massachusetts Avenue between River Street and Vassar Street
Vassar Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Main Street
Main Street between Vassar Street and Ames Street
Ames Street between Main Street and Memorial Drive
Wadsworth Street from Memorial Drive to Amherst Street
Amherst Street from Wadsworth Street to Ames Street
Sidney Street from Massachusetts Avenue to Green Street
Green Street from Sidney Street to Western Avenue
Western Avenue from Green Street to Memorial Drive

We also recommend that the service be "Closed Door" except for stops on Vassar Street at about number 50/51 and on Amherst Street at Wadsworth Street.

Similar service has been operating for the past several years with no problems.

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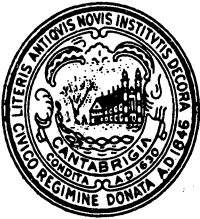
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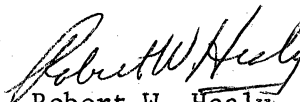
