- WHEREAS: Eugene attended local public schools and was a graduate of Northeastern University and after graduation he served his country during World War II; and
- WHEREAS: Upon being honorably discharged from the service, Eugene entered the civilian ranks of federal employees working at various naval facilities as a design engineer for thirty-five years prior to his retirement; and
- WHEREAS: Eugene was a 32nd degree Mason of the Prince Hall Masonic Order, where he served as a Past Master of Mount Zion Lodge, a member of the Consistory, and a member of the Shriners of Syria Temple #31; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Julia Phillips and to the entire Phillips family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Phillips on behalf of the entire City Council.
