Whereas, By a resolve, and order approved October 16, 1889, a certain parcel of private land therein described, situated at the junction of Cambridge and Hampshire Streets, was taken for public use, and made a public way of the City of Cambridge, it is therefore

Ordered, That due notice be given to Mary E. Waite, and all other persons interested as owners, proprietors, tenants, occupants, or otherwise, in said land that they cut off, pull down, remove and carry away all buildings, erections, and obstructions of every sort standing on or projecting over the line at the junction of Cambridge and Hampshire Streets, as established by the resolve and order aforesaid, or move and set back the same to the said line, and vacate and surrender the land and premises taken as aforesaid, on or before the first day of December now next ensuing; and in default thereof the Board of Aldermen will forthwith enter upon said land, and cause all buildings, erections and obstructions standing on and projecting over the lines at the said junction of Cambridge and Hampshire Streets, as established by the resolve and order aforesaid, to be cut off, pulled down, and carried away, or sold in such manner as said board shall deem expedient, or to be moved and set back to said line, and the land to be vacated and surrendered to said city.
