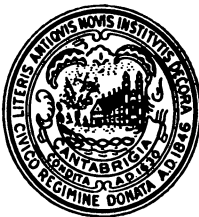

To the Honorable, the City Council:


I do hereby transmit a communication requesting authorization for transfer of \$178,000 from the Miscellaneous Salary Adjustment Account to various accounts in the City Hospital.

The amounts requested have been agreed to after a meeting Friday afternoon between Messrs. MacLeod, Vellucci, Heye, Libitz and LeBlanc, and are designed to maintain current operations and pay for all anticipated obligations through April 30, 1974, including bills of prior years.

It has become clear over the past number of months that in order to insure that the City Hospital will begin its new budget year July 1, 1974 with a clean slate and an inherent capacity to operate in an efficient and business-like manner, it is necessary that a concerted effort be made by the administrative and financial offices here at City Hall beyond their already extensive involvement.

Accordingly, please be advised that the City Auditor, Purchasing Agent and the Acting Director of Budget-Personnel have agreed to meet on a regular basis each week, together with the Director of Cambridge Hospital, the President of the Medical Staff and, hopefully, the Chairman of the Council Committee on Hospitals. This Hospital Administrative Review Committee shall be charged with the responsibility of recommending substantive changes in the internal fiscal operations of Cambridge Hospital. I will recommend to City Manager Sullivan that he engage the services of Peat, Marwick, Mitchell and Co., who have already conducted a preliminary study of the hospital situation.
