- WHEREAS: The bicycle is an important form of transportation in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Bicycling can present a hazard if the rules of the road are not properly followed; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to get the Traffic and Police Departments together to develop regulations, if necessary, and to see that they are enforced, with regard to the following:
- (1) Bicycles to stay off of sidewalks;
 - (2) Bicyclists to ride with the traffic flow and not the wrong way on one-way streets; and,
 - (3) Bicyclists to stop at stop lights; and be it further
- ORDERED: That a continued effort be made to enforce regulations against double-parking, that provides such a hazard for bicyclists.
