CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 12th, 1893.

WHEREAS,

The Board of Aldermen, by an order passed June 27th, 1893 laid assessments upon real estate owned by sundry persons, on account of sidewalks in certain streets named in said order, and

WHEREAS,

The hereinafter named person whose estate was so assessed, as aforesaid has duly notified this Board to apportion his said assessment, according to law. It is therefore

ORDERED,

That the assessment for sidewalk sewer laid upon real estate owned by the person hereinafter named, be and hereby is apportioned into three equal parts, and that such apportionment be certified to the Board of Assessors, who shall add one of said parts with interest from the date of apportionment, to the annual tax upon the real estate of said person for each of the three years next ensuing.

ORDERED,

That the City Treasurer be and hereby is instructed to desist and refrain from the collection of the assessment aforesaid, except as he shall receive the several apportioned parts upon warrants from the Board of Assessors.
