The Company has filed a tariff of rates and charges for its services which is being investigated by the Department and suspended until October 8, 1992.

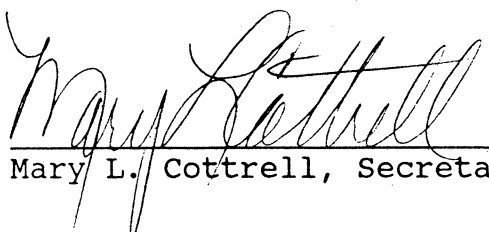

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in the following tariff: M.D.P.U. No. 1, Original Title Page, Original pages 1 through 58, inclusive, filed with the Department on March 5, 1992 to become effective April 8, 1992 by Norstan Network Services, Inc.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before August 31, 1992.

The Petitioner, Norstan Network Services, Inc., is required to give notice by publications hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Boston Herald, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [August 31, 1992], on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication no later than August 31, 1992.
