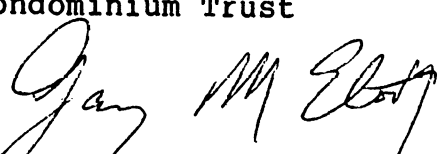
Re: Making Market St. One Way
