Dear Sir:

The Cambridge branch of the NAACP at its last meeting endorses the position of Commissioner of Police. We feel that the need of such position is vital. Police work today being professional, it should be a person with a wide variety of skills.

Although we endorse this, we would like to have our ideas implemented into this process:

1. The duties of the Police Commissioner should be the same as Boston.
2. There should be a committee made up of a wide range of citizens, including as many minorities as possible to serve on said committee.
3. Chairman of the Committee should be appointed by Committee.
4. All Affirmative Action Laws should be adhered to.
5. Advertisement should be wide-ranged so as to get best qualified candidates.
6. Advertisement should be 30 days after Ordinance is passed.
7. Commissioner should be hired no later than October 1, 1977.

These are the recommendations we feel would make the process work.
