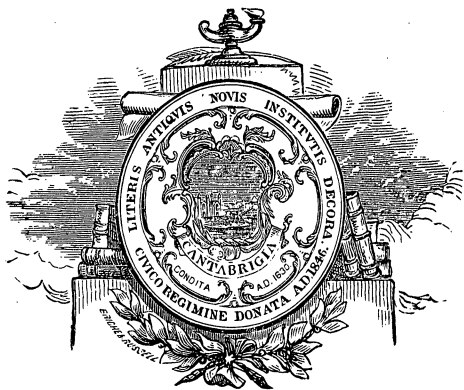

forty feet
in width between *North Avenue* and
Orchard Street

included between the

red

lines as shown on a plan drawn by

W. A. Mason & Son

and dated *May 17, 1883*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that

no

damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*

several owners and abutters, having agreed in writing
to waive the usual notice of such taking, and to
claim no damages therefor.
