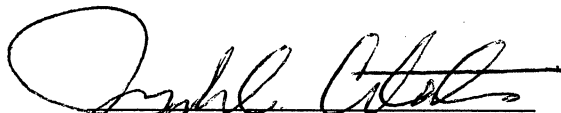

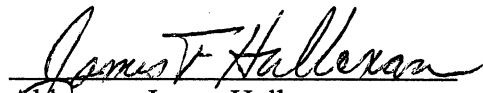

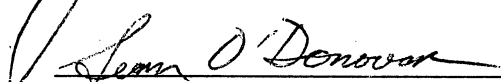

AMENDED, That the Metropolitan Area Planning Council also be included in this project.

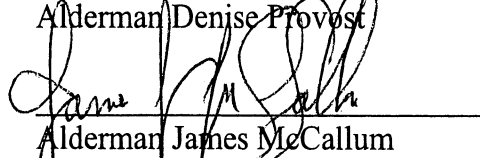
