To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$4,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account from the Somerville Cambridge Elder Service's Title IIIC program. The Council on Aging will use these funds for the Elder Haitian Meals Program. This multiservice program provides transportation, meals, social, education, recreation and health services for health services for elder Haitians. Each year SCES reimburses the Council on Aging for up to 25 meals a week at the rate of \$3.30 a meal. This money is a reimbursed on a month by month basis by SCES upon receipt of our Elder Haitian Nutrition Reports.
