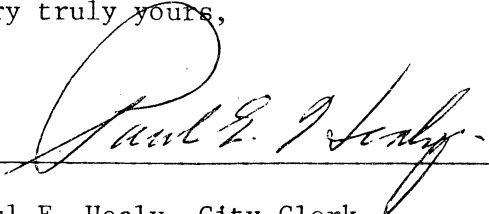

That the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., hereby resolved to request the appropriate officials of Chile to make public the reasons for the arrest of Muriel Cornejo Bustamenta, Patricia Miranda Verdejo, Jose Anselmo Navarrete Pino, Jose de Grigorio, Daniel Sierra, Luis Eduardo Fuentealba Reyes, Maria Rozas Velasquez, Gabriel Valdes, Gonzalo Duarte, and Jorge Lavandros, and to advise whether the rights of these persons are being observed under the United National Universal Declaration of Human Rights. As elected government officials in a democratic society, the Cambridge City Councillors wish to say to Chilean officials that political activity should never result in the violation of a person's liberty, and further that disregard of the personal rights of members of political opposition creates a destabilizing force in the world.

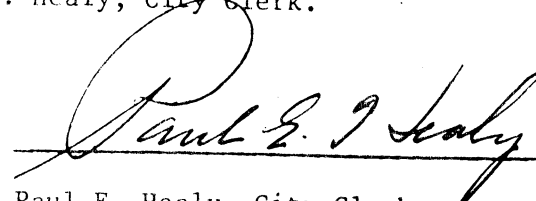
