An Ordinance

in further addition to "An Ordinance providing for
the care and management of the Cambridge Water
works."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cam-
bridge as follows:

Sec. 1. All hydrants established by the City shall
be constructed, and all repairs upon such hydrants
shall be made, and the streets if broken up, again
put in good order, ^{to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets and Sewers,} by and under the direction of the
Water Board.

Sec. 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in-
consistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
