Dear City Council Members:

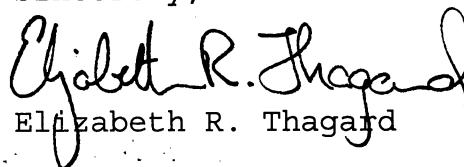
