That the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) be and hereby is appropriated for the construction of sewers for sanitary purposes and for sewage disposal as authorized by Section 5 (1), Chapter 719, Acts of the Year 1913

and it is further

Ordered

That a City Debt be Created

for the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for the purpose of constructing sewers for sanitary purposes and for sewage disposal as authorized by Section 5 (1), Chapter 719, Acts of the Year 1913

and from time to time as the City Treasurer may deem necessary bonds of the City will be issued not exceeding that amount, either in the form of registered or coupon bonds, one or both, to be styled

SEWER CONSTRUCTION LOAN

loan said ~~loan~~ to be ~~payable~~ payable in accordance with the provisions of Section 14, Chapter 719, Acts of the Year 1913, so that the whole loan shall be paid in not more than thirty years from the date of the first bond issued or at such earlier dates as the City Treasurer, Mayor and City Auditor may determine

with interest at the rate of not exceeding $5\frac{1}{2}$ per centum per annum, payable semi-annually; that the Mayor, City Auditor and City Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and instructed to sign and execute said bonds and all transfers and exchanges of the same in the manner directed by the ordinances of the City, and that the City Treasurer be and is hereby directed to bargain and sell, and is hereby authorized to transfer and exchange the same.

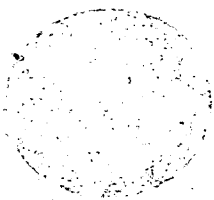

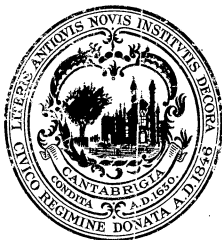

I wish to call your attention to the condition of the appropriation for Sewer Construction General. There was appropriated for this account during the year 1919 the sum of \$68,350.89.

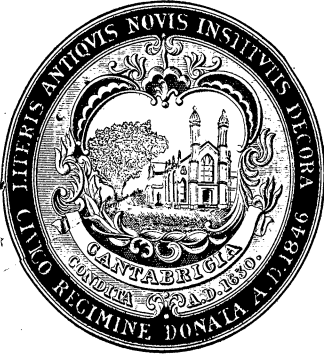
There has been expended to April 1, 1920, about \$64,150.00, leaving an unexpended balance of about \$4,200. available for the work of 1920.

If it is considered wise to continue the work of construction of sanitary sewers this coming year, it will be necessary to make a large additional appropriation to the sum now available as given above, viz. \$4,200.

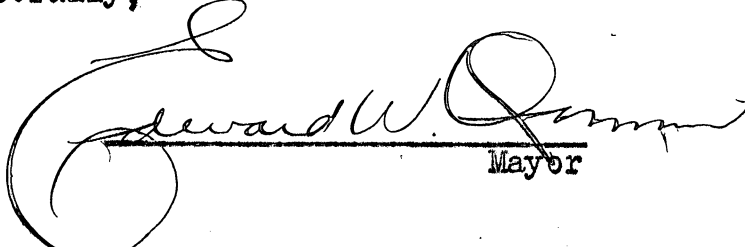

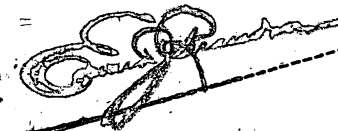
