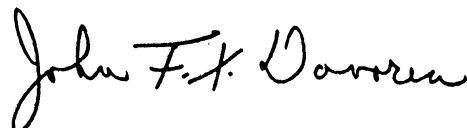

CONTINUATION SHEET #1

In furtherance of the educational, scientific, literary and charitable purposes for which this corporation is incorporated, the corporation shall have the power:

- a. To accept by gift, devise, bequest, grant or otherwise, property of every kind or description, without limit as to amount;
- b. To purchase, take on lease or otherwise acquire, hold, invest, reinvest, use, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of both real and personal property of every kind, nature and description and every interest in any property; and to exercise in respect of any and all property any and all rights and privileges of ownership in such manner as, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, will best promote the objectives of the corporation;
- c. To have officers and to promote and carry out its objectives and purposes and to exercise its powers within and without the Commonwealth of Massachusetts;
- d. To enter into, make, perform and carry out any contracts or agreements for any purposes or objectives herein set forth without limit as to amount, with any individual, firm, association, corporation or entity;
- e. To do everything and anything reasonably and lawfully necessary, suitable, proper or convenient for the achievement of the purposes above stated, and for any of them, or for the furtherance of said purposes.

Except as otherwise required by law, these Articles of Organization of the corporation may be amended from time to time by the affirmative vote of not less than a majority of its Board of Directors present at a meeting, provided that no amendment shall authorize or permit the corporation to be operated otherwise than exclusively for purposes permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as in force on the date of incorporation or as hereafter amended.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

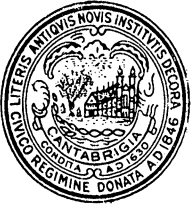
1. To educate the general public on contemporary social-political phenomena, critically focusing on political assassination and its role in conspiratorial political power struggles, in the belief that a well-educated public is essential to the preservation of a open democratic society.

2. To provide a means by which sepearate research projects may be co-ordinated and centralized.

3. To serve as a non-partison central information bureau on the subject of political assassination for both the general public, educational institutions, and government representatives.

4. To develop and expand contacts with the communications media, publish a newsletter, and hold conferences and lectures and other public events to assist and further the educational goals of the corporation.

5. To secure and/or aid in securing funding for research in the areas discussed above.

Pursuant to a communication from the Secretary of State re: "Assassination Information Bureau Inc.," I made an investigation. The locus is suitable.

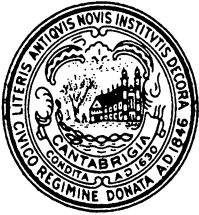
