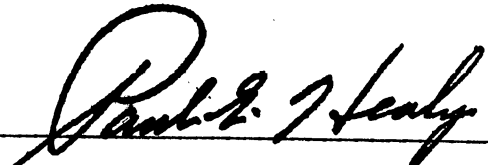

- WHEREAS: The Massachusetts Legislature recently enacted law which was subsequently signed by Governor Michael S. Dukakis, creating a new agency to be known as the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA); and
- WHEREAS: The start up of any new governmental unit is a difficult and laborious task, requiring the expertise of many individuals who are both willing and able to provide assistance in the embryonic stages of an agency; and
- WHEREAS: Governor Dukakis, realizing these difficulties, looked for an individual who has proven leadership and administrative ability and chose our own City Manager Robert W. Healy to serve as Chairman Pro-Tem of the Advisory Board created to assist the Governor in creating the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority and to provide the Authority with the necessary assistance in implementing its legislative mandate; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations to City Manager Robert W. Healy upon being chosen by the Governor to assist with the development of this new agency; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the City Manager on behalf of the entire City Council.
