to which was referred the petition of Piquet O'Keefe
and others, praying for the extension of Albans Street
from its present terminus to Grant Street,

Reports

That the improvements
asked for by the petitioners would require the pur-
chase by the city, and the removal of two dwelling-
houses. These and the land upon which they stand
are taxed upon a valuation of \$1900.- Inasmuch
as there is no appropriation to which such an ex-
penditure could be charged, and it does not appear
that the public necessity and convenience require
that the street be opened as prayed for, your committee
recommends that the petitioners have leave to withdraw.
