To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$66,150.00 in the General Fund of the Police Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Police Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account for the purchase of a wagon and motorcycles. Professional Ambulance has bid to provide services to the City at no cost for the upcoming year. The funds allocated in the FY95 budget for ambulance service, therefore, will now be used for the purchase of a wagon and two motorcycles. The new wagon will replace the ten year old customized van which is presently being used as a wagon. Also, the two new motorcycles will expand the motorcycle force from four to six which will be used to expand coverage during peak traffic hours.
