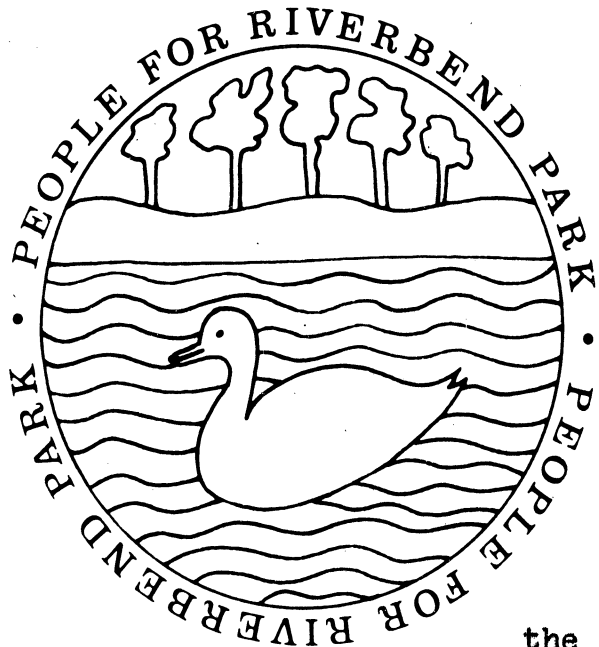

To the City Clerk:

We wish to present this petition to the City Council and to have a hearing on the following proposal, *on Monday, June 16th*

On Sunday May 25, 1388 residents of Cambridge signed a petition supporting the permanent closing of Memorial Drive, in order to create a riverside park. Understanding the obstacles in closing Memorial Drive on a full-time basis at this time, we ask the City Council to vote in favor of the following proposal:

In order that more recreational space be provided for the citizens of Cambridge, Memorial Drive should be closed to traffic from Eliot Bridge to Western Avenue Bridge on Sundays this summer, beginning as soon as possible and extending through October, subject to the approval ~~and~~ and with the cooperation of the Metropolitan District Commission.

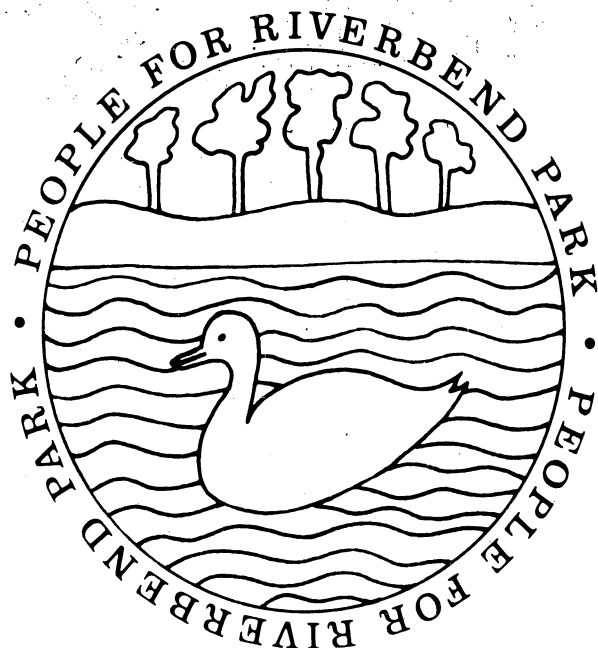
