COUNCILLOR DANEHY

- WHEREAS:** This City Council was deeply saddened to learn of the death of Dr. Francis Herzan, former Chief of Radiology at the Cambridge Hospital, and
- WHEREAS:** Dr. Herzan received his medical degree from Charles University in Prague and completed post graduate studies at the Universities of Vienna and Berlin, and
- WHEREAS:** Dr. Herzan, after the allied liberation of Czechoslovakia, joined the Czech army and was appointed radiologist at the Military Hospital in Slany where he worked until 1948 when he moved to Canada and served as staff radiologist at the Hotel Dieu Hospital in Montreal, and
- WHEREAS:** In 1949, Dr. Francis Herzan came to the United States and during his time here he was credited with many innovative contributions to the study of radiology, and
- WHEREAS:** He was appointed a teaching fellowship in radiology at Harvard University while serving at the Cambridge Hospital where in 1954 he was appointed Chief of Radiology, a position he held until his retirement in 1974, and
- WHEREAS:** The Cambridge Hospital changed the name of the radiology department to "The Herzan Radiological Unit" in recognition of this man's outstanding service to the Cambridge Hospital, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to Mrs. Helen Herzan and her family at their time of great sorrow, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family of Dr. Francis Herzan on behalf of this council.
