- WHEREAS: On the fourth day of September 1980, death brought to a close the active life of Daniel P. Collins at the age of eighty-three, and
- WHEREAS: Daniel P. Collins, a lifelong resident of Cambridge, graduated from Cambridge High and Latin School and Suffolk Law School prior to his admission to the Bar of the Commonwealth in 1943, and
- WHEREAS: Daniel P. Collins was active in the fraternal life of the City of Cambridge as a member of Cambridge Lodge of Elks #839, the Knights of Columbus and the Holy Name Society of the Sacred Heart Church and served his native city as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Cambridge Public Library from 1969 to 1980, and
- WHEREAS: Attorney Daniel P. Collins was recognized as an expert in the field of labor and served the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as Chief Counsel for the State Labor Relations Board prior to his retirement at the age of seventy and was known and loved for his eagerness to be of assistance to all who sought his advise and was admired for his sound judgment, high sense of honor and gregarious nature, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the members of the Cambridge City Council in meeting assembled this twenty-second day of September, 1980 do hereby express our sorrow at the passing of Daniel P. Collins, Esquire and acknowledge the great contributions of his public service and extend to his wife, Mary, and to his family our most sincere condolences, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution be prepared and presented to Mr. Collins' Family to record our sorrow at his passing.
