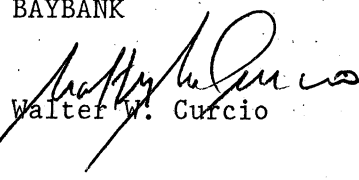

MAYOR WOLF

WHEREAS: There is a great deal of illegal parking generated by the ATM kiosk on Massachusetts Avenue by Wendell Street; and

WHEREAS: This is a particular problem because people using the machine often park in a bus stop, thus creating a safety hazard and making the exact location of the bus stop rather unclear; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is instructed to vigorously enforce parking regulations at the bus stop at Massachusetts Avenue and Wendell Street; and be it further

ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council urges Baybank to rent one or two parking spaces, possibly from National Car Rental nearby, to resolve the problem of people parking at the bus stop to use the cash machine; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is instructed to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this order to send to Baybank officials.
