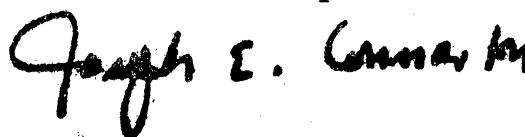
COUNCILLOR DANEHY
