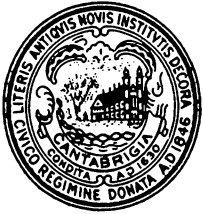

Eliminate Accumulation of Rain Water in Rindge Avenue,
Jefferson Park and Sherman Street Area

The rain water accumulation between Jefferson Park and Sherman Street is as a result of the deterioration of the street. This street was resurfaced under the Chapter 90 Program in 1971. The continuing truck traffic has increased the deterioration of the pavement more rapidly than should be experienced. Permanent repair will involve a major expenditure of funds. The department this spring will attempt to make some temporary repairs to alleviate the hazard to the school children. However, long term solutions cannot be made at this time.

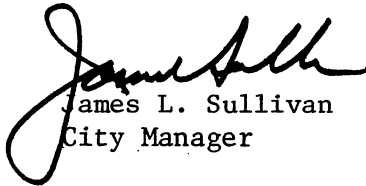
