Stallings, who will attend Wheaton College in the fall, has the 55-meter record at the Class meet with a time of 7.21. She will also run outdoor track this spring.



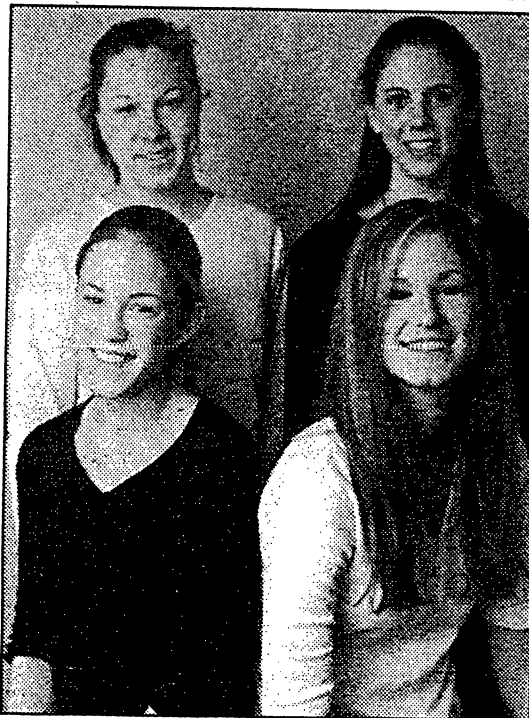
JESS TITUS Hopkinton

Titus dominated the shot put during the winter track season. Titus, a senior, won the Tri-Valley League, Class D and All-State titles in the shot put. She placed second at the New Englands and sixth at the nationals in the event. Titus, who is headed to Northern, has a school record of 40 feet, 6 inches in the shot put. Titus also plays volleyball.

Needham's 4x200 relay team consisting of Jaclyn Raffol (back right), Jill Zagami (front right), Kim Kelly (front left) and Liz Moderi (back left) captured the Class B and New England (1:46.12) titles this past winter. Kelly, a senior, was the Class B champ in the 300 (41.5) and will attend Middlebury in the fall. Moderi, a senior, was fourth in the 55 meters at the New England meet.
