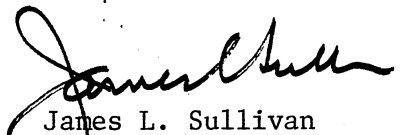

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The Advisory Board, established under statute to make recommendations to the Secretary of Administration and Finance on the disposition of Parcel 1B of the southwest sector of Harvard Square, met on Friday, March 10, to vote on its recommendation. On a 3 - 2 vote of the Advisory Board the Carpenter/Cambridge Seven proposal was recommended.

The actual decision on the disposition of the property will be made by the Secretary of Administration and Finance after a public hearing to be held on the project. In addition, the developer chosen will be required to go through the P. U. D. process under the City of Cambridge zoning regulations. The concerns expressed by the neighborhood can and should be addressed during the hearing by the Secretary of Administration and Finance and during the P. U. D. process required by the City of Cambridge.
