- WHEREAS: Tom was educated in our local schools, graduating from the former Rindge Technical High School and also attended Bentley College of Accounting and Finance, as well as serving his country during World War II in the Army Air Force, holding the rank of Lieutenant at the time of his honorable discharge; and
- WHEREAS: Tom was active in the Cambridge Community for most of his adult life and devoted much of his own time to such civic organizations as the Cambridge Lions Club where he served as president for several years, the Cambridge Lodge of Elks No. 839 where he was the post chaplain and as a member of the North Cambridge Betterment Association; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deep sympathy to Mrs. Agnes Reilly and the Reilly family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
