That the Committee on Ordinances be instructed to prepare and report an Ordinance amending the 41<sup>st</sup> section of chapter 10<sup>th</sup> of the Revised Ordinances, so as to make the compensation of the Drivers and members of the Hook and Ladder Company, from and after the first day of March, 1872, the same as the compensation provided in said section for the Drivers and members of Steamed Companies, - being an increase of \$5.00 per month for the Drivers, and \$2.00 per month for each member, and making the compensation of the members of the Fire Department uniform.

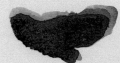
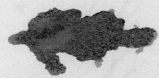
