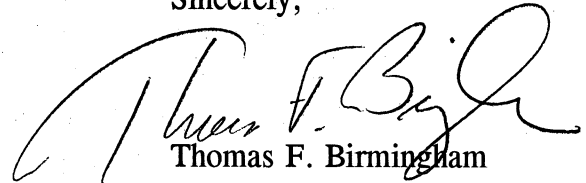
Dear Councilors:
