

PRINCIPALS OF ST. PAUL'S SCHOOL, CAMBRIDGE

From the founding of St. Paul's parish school in 1889 until the graduation of its last class in 1974, over 220 women of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph served the school in some capacity. For the first eighty years, the parish provided a convent for their residence and the community superior generally also held the position of principal.

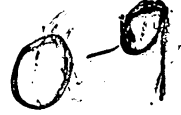
