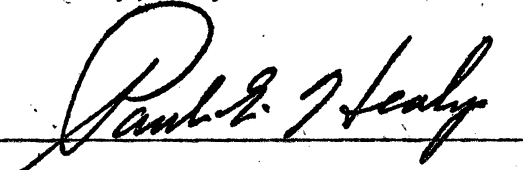

- WHEREAS: Walter was appointed to the Cambridge Police Department in 1949 and attained the rank of Sergeant prior to leaving the Department in 1967 to join the Alcoholic Beverage Commission as an Investigator; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Frances Smith and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
